Events for Point Pleasant Battle Days are scheduled from Friday, Oct. 5 thru Sunday, Oct. 7.

The Candlelight tour of Battle Monument State Park will be Friday starting at 7:30 p.m.

On Saturday, the Battle Days Parade will commence at 11 a.m. on Main Street at Tenth Street.

The Colonial Governor's Reception and Colonial Ball are set Saturday at American Legion Post 23.

On Sunday at 10 a.m. there will be an outdoor Early Colonial Church Service at Tu-Endie-Wei State Park.

The main event on Sunday will be the memorial service to commemorate the Battle of Point Pleasant of Oct. 10, 1774. It will be conducted at 2 p.m. at Tu-Endie-Wei State Park.
