A Revolutionary War patriot grave marking is set Friday, July 4, for soldier Thomas Harbert. The grave marking will begin at 2:30 p.m. at Harbert-Chicarelli Family Cemetery in Lumbeport, Harrison County.

Harbert was born July 4, 1734 at Monmouth County, New Jersey. The soldier died March 3, 1778 at Harbert's Fort, Harrison County.
